Jennifer served as concertmaster of both UM orchestras and has been involved in music festivals nationally and internationally. In addition to performing, she shares a passion for teaching with the students of her private studio in Farmington Hills. Beyond the music realm, she enjoys spending time with her husband and golden retriever, Simba.

Priscilla Johnson, violinist, has performed and taught in Southeast Michigan for over thirty years. After obtaining both a Bachelor of Music Degree and a Master of Music Degree in performance from The University of Michigan, her extensive free – lancing career has included concerts with the Ann Arbor, Flint, Saginaw and Lansing Symphony Orchestras. Priscilla has also performed with James Dapogny, Louis Nagel, Johnny Mathis, Harry Connick Jr. and a host of others.
